Memorandum of Agreement Between Ramapo College of New Jersey, The Council of New Jersey State College Locals, AFT, AFL-CIO and the Ramapo Federation of Teachers Local 2274

Student Opinion Surveys - Spring 2020

In order to promote amicable employer-employee relations, Ramapo College of New Jersey (hereinafter "Ramapo College"), The Council of New Jersey State College Locals, AFT, AFL-CIO (hereinafter "the Council") and the Ramapo Federation of Teachers, Local 2274 (hereinafter "the Union"), hereby agree to the following:

- 1. It is agreed that as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, effective for the Spring 2020 semester only, all full-time and adjunct faculty will not be required to administer the student opinion surveys.
- 2. It is also agreed that as a result of not administering these evaluations, there will be no negative consequences as it pertains to this operational decision.
- 3. The parties agree that this Memorandum of Agreement shall not constitute a precedent and shall not be cited in any forum except to enforce the provisions herein. In addition, this Memorandum of-Agreement shall not set a precedent for any other agreement negotiated either locally or in the collectively negotiated master AGREEMENT.
